Highbrook Business Park takes out **top spot** at Property Council of NZ Awards.

Our most strategic and valuable asset, the Highbrook Business Park, now boasts ‘best of the best’ status after being selected for the Supreme Award at this year’s Property Council of NZ Awards.

Highbrook was chosen for this prestigious award from a high number of outstanding entrants for its “tireless planning and design, the adherence to the master plan, the attention to detail and the level of collaboration with the Manukau City Council to achieve what is an outstanding development,” according to Property Council chief executive, Connal Townsend.

An annual event, the Property Council of NZ Awards are a celebration of excellence in property development, with a particular emphasis on efficient use of capital, maximum investor return, and for public buildings, the greatest community benefit.

Highbrook Business Park is the product of a joint venture between Goodman Property Trust, the Goodman Group and the Fisher Family, which could eventually offer employment to more than 10,000 people.

In April 2011 the green light was given to invest in a town centre precinct at the heart of Highbrook. Stage 1 of ‘The Crossing’ project will involve developing approximately 9,800 sqm of land at the centre of the Park and is intended to provide services such as restaurants, food bars, medical rooms, fitness facilities and general retail in addition to office and accommodation space, that includes a 62 room serviced apartment complex.
